### St. Ann's designated as a Jubilee Ministry Center

St. Ann's has been chosen to be designated a Jubilee Center. We are the first one in the Diocese of Tennessee. Jubilee Ministries are in The Social and Economic Justice Office of the Episcopal Church Center in New York.

Jubilee Ministries are congregations or agencies with connections to the Episcopal Church whose mission efforts affect the lives of people in need, addressing basic human needs and justice issues. An application was submitted at the beginning of the year with the Vestry's endorsement. St. Ann's will also receive regular communication about other Jubilee Ministries and possible resources and availability of funding.

### \$1,000 Jubilee Ministries Grant Awarded to St. Ann's for East Nashville Hope Exchange

St. Ann's is a 2011 recipient of a grant as a Jubilee Center. One of the categories designated for funding includes summer camp programs targeting literacy and children of people incarcerated. St. Ann's is one of 24 recipients nationally awarded \$1000.

The ENHE Grants Committee chair, Graham Carpenter, followed up on the discussion about becoming a Jubilee Center with Rick Britton and proceeded to complete a grant application. There may be future opportunities for funding to support other outreach ministries of St. Ann's.
